TRACKSIDE SIGNAGE ASSOCIATED WITH DIGITAL SYSTEMS TRAIN TESTING

From Thursday, 30 April 2026 until Friday, 30 October 2026 this Permanent SAFE Notice cancels and replaces Permanent SAFE Notice 001 – 2026 due to signage updates.

This Permanent SAFE Notice advertises trackside signage that has been installed on the Up and Down Branch lines between Sutherland and Cronulla in association with the Digital Systems project roll out.

The trackside signage has been installed for testing and pre-commissioning purposes only and Drivers are to disregard these signs at all other times.

The signs and/or signposts have been marked with a White Cross (X) to show they can be disregarded, and this SAFE Notice provides examples of the installed signs.
