MOUNT VICTORIA (WEST) – MOUNT VICTORIA AREA REMODELLING (MVAR) – NEW AND RELOCATED CAR MARKERS

On **Monday, 5 October 2020** the following works will be carried out:

- Changes to existing Car Markers to differentiate NIF 'D' Sets stabling arrangements from 'V' Set stabling arrangements at Mt Victoria
- New 10, 20 and 30 Car Markers will be installed in the 4 Foot of the Mt Victoria Yard for NIF Trains, the locations are as follows:
 - Up Siding No.1 – 10 car marker at 127.297km (E245525.8, N6280716.3), 20 car marker at 127.512km (E245533.1, N6280931.6), 30 car marker at 127.726km (E245518.8, N6281144.8)
 - Up Siding No.2 – 10 car marker at 127.298km (E245527.9, N6280716.2), 20 car marker at 127.513km (E245535.099, N6280931.6), 30 car marker at 127.728km (E245524.0, N6281145.4)
 - Up Storage Siding 1 – 10 car marker at 127.282km (E245538.4, N6280694.1)
 - Up Storage Siding 2 – 10 car marker at 127.294km (E245544.2, N6280704.5)
 - Up Storage Siding 3 – 10 car marker at 127.294km (E245550.1, N6280702.6)
- V Set Car markers in the 4 Foot will be removed and existing car markers on the driver's walkway will be retained with a "V" Prefix (Eg. V8).
- An additional 2 car marker will also be installed at 126.797km (E245433.4, N6280229.4) for the new Up Side Decant facility

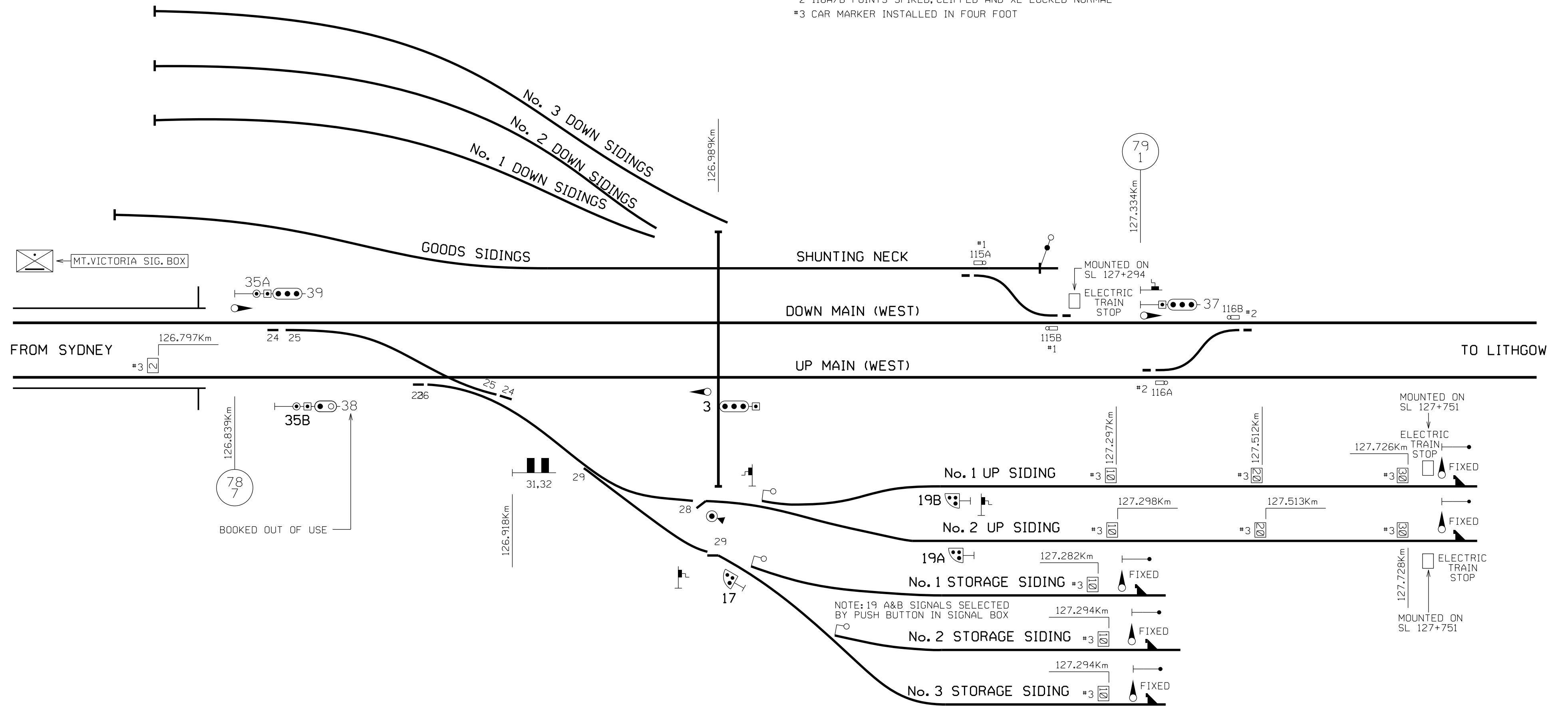

BROADMEADOW – RENEWAL OF 433N/S POINTS TO D84M MKIII & RELOCATION OF GROUND SHUNT SIGNAL 258

Commencing at 0200 hours on **Saturday, 3 October 2020**, and continuing until 0200 hours on Tuesday, 6 October 2020, the following work shall be carried out:

- 433N/S crossover (Up Main to Up Relief) will be renewed.
- The operating mechanisms will be upgraded to D84M MKIII with in-bearer spherolocks.
- 433S points will be re-located approximately 3.1m towards Sydney.
- 433N points will be re-located approximately 0.2m towards the country.
- 433N/S Emergency Switch Machine Lock (ESML) will be replaced with an Emergency Operation Lock (EOL) of the Fortress key type in the same position for emergency hand operation.
- Ground shunt signal 258 will be relocated approximately 3m towards Sydney. The indications displayed and the form of the signal will remain unchanged.
- No changes will be made to Broadmeadow Control Panel.

- Existing 47.3 signal on the Down Main at Tascott will have a medium aspect added.
- Existing 48.1 signal on the Down Main at Tascott will have a medium aspect added.
- Existing 48.7 signal on the Down Main at Pt Clare will be renewed and relocated 20 metres towards Sydney at 78.383 km.
- The renewed 48.7 signal will have a Left Hand and Right Hand Turnout Repeater provided, which will be covered and out of use. 48.7 signal will retain its existing aspects without change.

GOSFORD (NORTH) – GOSFORD AREA REMODELLING (GAR) STAGE 9 WORKS – RENEWEL OF 19 POINTS & INSTALLATION OF NEW 107 CATCH POINT

Commencing at 0200 hours on **Saturday, 3 October 2020**, and continuing until 2300 hours on Monday, 5 October 2020, the following work will be carried out:

- Existing 19B independent switch becomes 19B points and will be relocated 5 metres towards Sydney at 80.763km.
- 14B independent switch will be removed and 14A catch point will remain in use.
- 19A points will be relocated 1 metre towards Country at 80.643km.
- 19A and 19B WESTINGHOUSE M3A point machines will be replaced with Siemens D84M MKIII point machines utilising an in-bearer Spherolocks arrangement.
- The Existing 19 ESML will be replaced by new 19A & 19B Emergency Operation Lock (EOL) in the same location.
- In conjunction with the planned track renewal in the Down South Siding, new 107 catch point will be installed at 80.624Km, booked out of use, spiked, clipped and XL locked reverse.

ATP AREA, 6.2, 8.1 & 8.2 – INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF ATP VIRTUAL BALISE COVER (VBC) BALISES

Since **Wednesday, 14 October 2020**, as part of the ATP Network Rollout in Area 6.2 Wentworthville to Auburn and Fairfield, Area 8.1 Fairfield to Turrella, Leppington, Berala and Bankstown and Area 8.2 New Southern Railway Central to Turrella, one hundred and fifty six (156) ATP balises (78 balise groups) known as Virtual Balise Covers (VBCs) has been commissioned and enter revenue service at the following locations:
