SYDNEY TERMINAL BUILDING REVITALISATION PROJECT (STBRP) – TEMPORARY CONCRETE PUMPING LINE INSTALLATION

As part of the Sydney Terminal Building Revitalisation Project (STBRP), a temporary static concrete pumping line will be installed to facilitate concrete supply to Eddy Plaza for ongoing construction activities.

The installation is scheduled to commence in early **December 2025** and will remain in place for approximately six months, until mid-2026.

The concrete line, approximately 365 metres in length, will be securely fixed to the ground and will run behind buildings from Sydney Yard, behind Platform 14, outside the danger zone rail corridor and alongside the Galvanised Steel Troughing to Eddy Plaza.

All concrete pumping operations will be conducted in full compliance with rail safety regulations. An approved methodology for concrete pumping has been developed and will be strictly adhered to throughout the duration of the works.

- Wongawilli Branch Line will be booked out of use. A stop block has been previously applied at the entry.
- 41.3 Shunt Route to enter the Wongawilli Branch Line will be booked out of use and disconnected.
- 41.4 Signal to depart Wongawilli will be booked out of use, blanked out and lamp alarm disabled.
- 49A Points will be clipped, spiked and XL locked in the normal position for mainline moves only.
- 49B Catchpoints will be spiked in the open position.

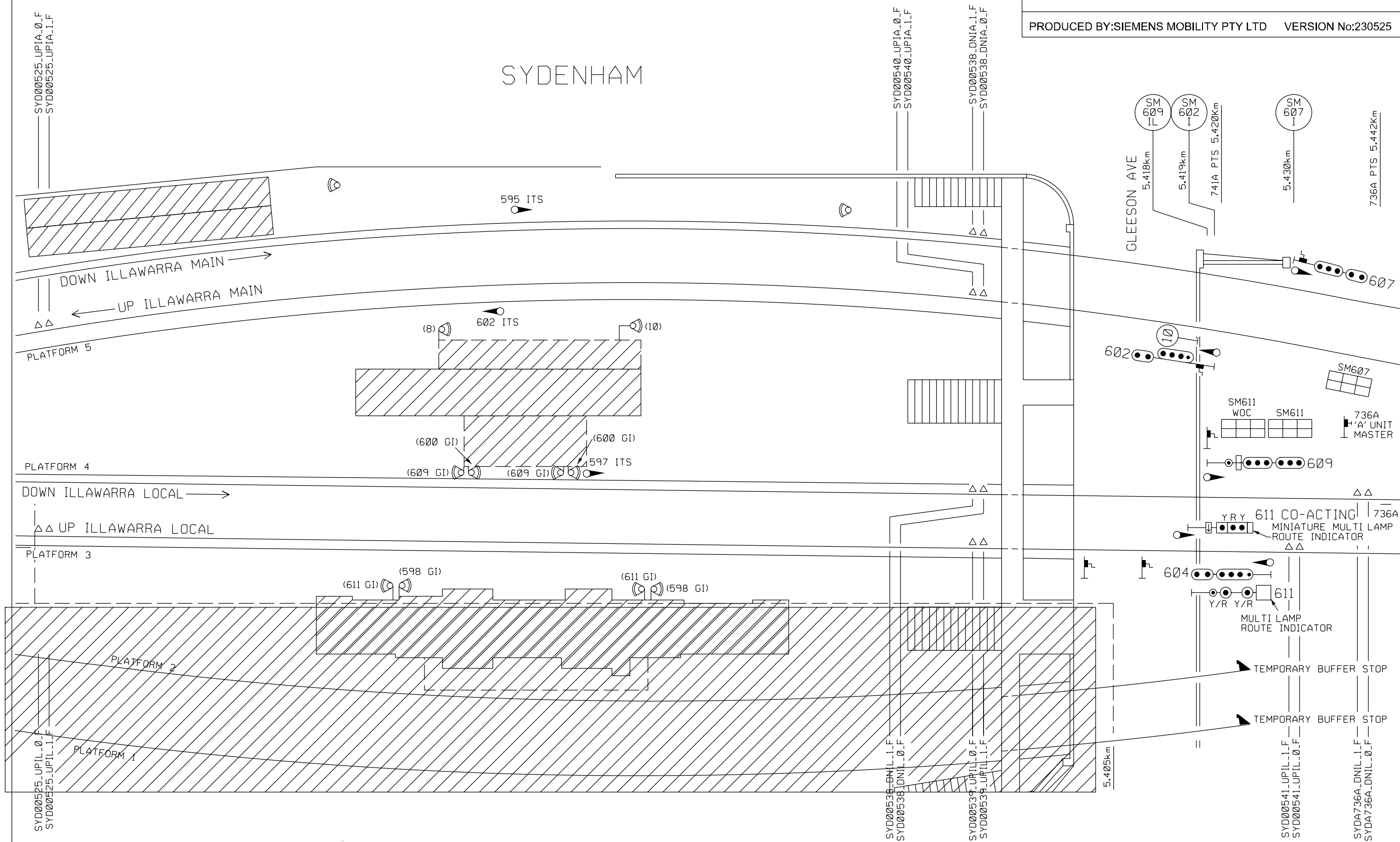

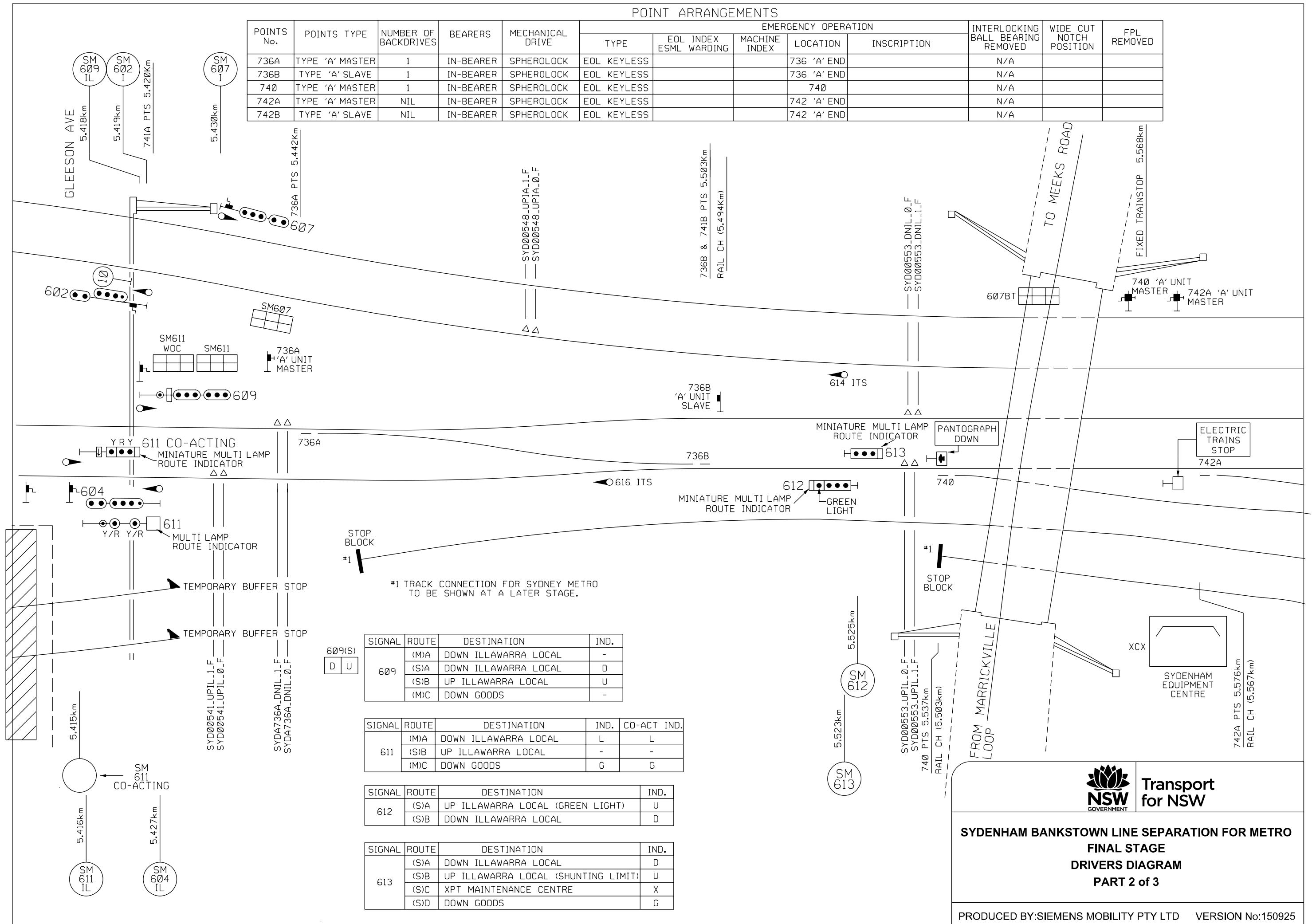

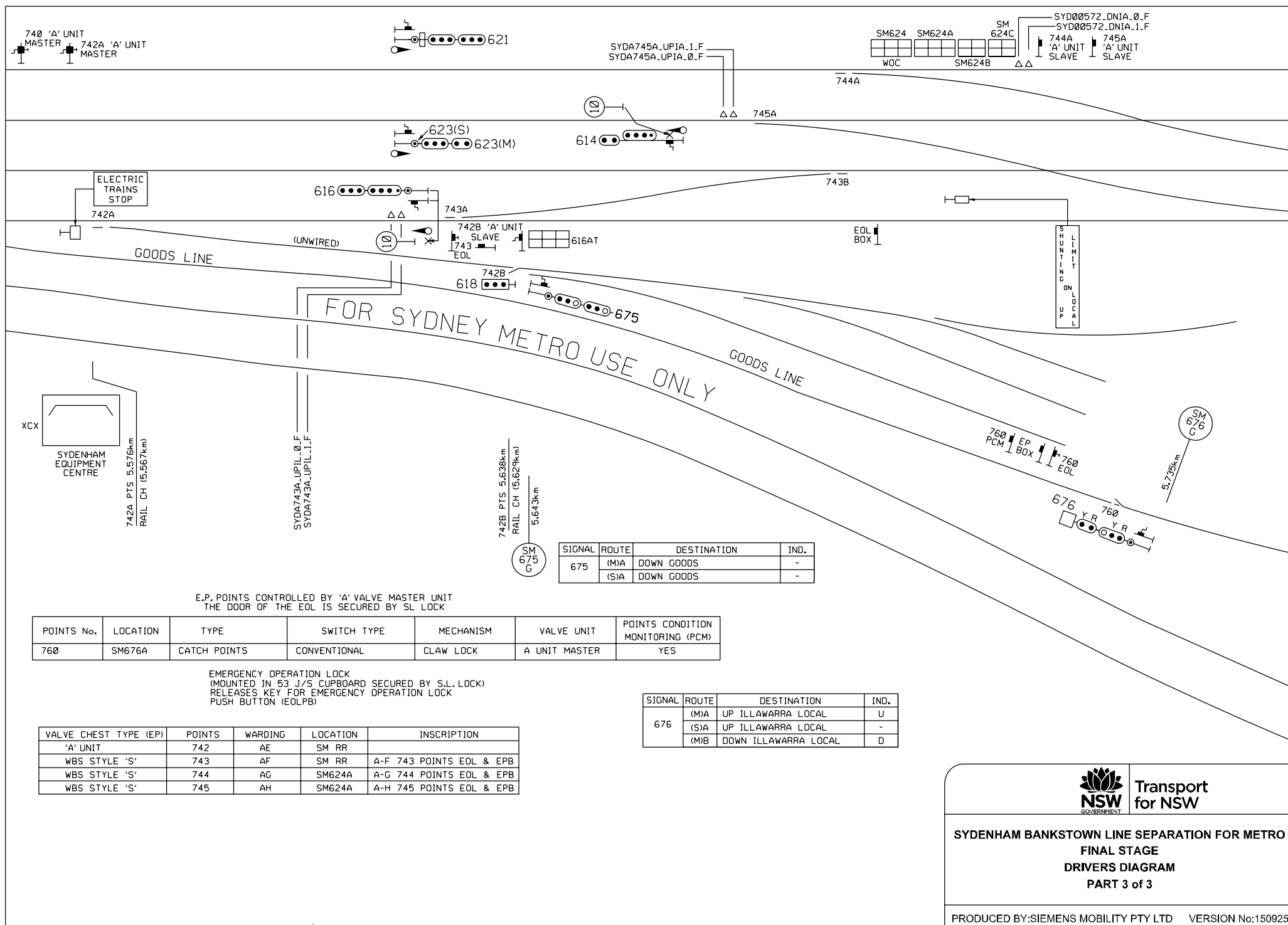
