In conjunction with Special Train Notice No. 0230 – 2023, the following Safeworking arrangements will apply:

I ADDITIONAL SAFEWORKING ARRANGEMENTS — WATERFALL

UP REFUGE LOOP

In exception to NWT 302, a worksite with associated rail traffic may be established on the Up Refuge Loop at Waterfall within 500m of the LPA limit in accordance with the site safety plan and the following:

Prior to a worksite being established the following additional protection must be provided for the duration of the work:

- A Temporary Friction Buffer Stop must be fixed to the Up Refuge Loop at approximately 38 + 746km
- Additional Railway Track Signals (RTS) must be placed on the worksite side of the Temporary Friction Buffer Stop at approximately 38 + 726km, 38 + 706km & 38 + 686km on the Up Refuge Loop.
- An additional Worksite Protection Marker must be placed on the Up Refuge Loop at approximately 38 + 686km

 Note: When it is necessary for a work train, track vehicle or plant to enter or depart the possession, it will be permissible for the Temporary Friction Buffer Stop and additional protection to be removed to allow the movement. Immediately after the work train or track vehicle has entered or departed the possession area, the Temporary Friction
