REDFERN (WELLS STREET) - RENEWAL OF 265B CATCH POINTS TO IN BEARER SPHEROLOCK AND INSTALLATION OF 120 AND 106/107 ITS TRAINSTOPS - STAGE 2

Commencing at **0200 hours on Saturday, 25 March 2023**, and continuing until 0200 hours on Monday, 27 March 2023, the following work will be carried out:

- 265B catch point on the Down Suburban (Yard) will be renewed with an In bearer spherlock arrangement and relocated approximately 22m towards Sydney.
- The existing Emergency Operations Lock (EOL) for 265 points remains unchanged located adjacent to 265A points.
- SY120 trainstop will be installed adjacent to SY120 signal on the Down Suburban (Yard) and suppressed for train movements in the up direction.
- SY106/107 intermediate trainstop will be installed adjacent to SY114 signal on the Down Suburban (Yard) and lowered on approach for movements in the down direction with a maximum set speed of 25 km/h when SY120 signal is at stop. The intermediate trainstop is suppressed for movements in the up direction using 114 signal.

WATERFALL (ILLAWARRA) – MTMS2 WATERFALL STABLING FACILITY PROJECT SIGNALLING – UPGRADES TO W79, W1, W20, W22, W26 AND W28 SIGNALS, RELOCATION OF W10 AND W12 SIGNALS, INSTALLATION OF W23 GANTRY SIGNAL AND UP ILLAWARRA TRACK SLEW BETWEEN 38.500KM – 38.772KM

Commencing at **0200 hours on Friday, 7 April 2023**, and continuing until 0200 hours on Tuesday, 11 April 2023, the following works will be carried out:

- A new turnout repeater will be fitted onto existing W79 signal and bagged (uncommissioned).
- The existing 2-way stencil route indicator (SRI) on W1 signal will be replaced with a 4-way SRI. The existing 'DR' and 'DM' indications will be displayed in the top left and bottom left quadrants respectively. The top right quadrant will be blanked out (uncommissioned).
- The existing left hand band of lights on W1 signal will be replaced with a combined left and right hand band of lights with the right hand indication blanked out (uncommissioned).
- W10 Signal and trainstop on the Up Main will be relocated to 38.568km.
- W12 Signal and trainstop on the Down Main will be relocated to 38.568km and profile changed. A stencil route indicator will be provided and bagged (uncommissioned).
- W23 signal on the Up Refuge Loop will be relocated to 38.713km, mounted on a gantry and profile changed. A stencil route indicator will be provided and bagged (uncommissioned).
 W23 trainstop will be relocated adjacent to the gantry signal.



- A ground level co-acting signal for W23 on the Up Refuge Loop will be installed at 38.721km. A miniature route indicator will be provided with 'D' and 'U' indications brought into use at this stage. These will operate in conjunction with the caution aspect on the co-acting signal indicating routes to the Down Main and Up Main respectively.
- The existing 4-way stencil route indicator (SRI) and shunt aspect on W20 signal and existing 2-way stencil route indicator (SRI) and shunt aspect on W22 signal will be replaced with combined 2-way miniature multi-lamp route indicators (MMLRI), low speed and shunt aspect modules respectively. The low speed aspects on W20 and W22 signals will be blanked out (uncommissioned).
- Existing W26 and W28 signals will be renewed as tri-colour LED.
 Turnout repeaters will be installed on both signals and bagged (uncommissioned).
- The Up Main track will be slewed between 38.500km to 38.772km in preparation for the platform extension to the Sydney end of Waterfall station at a later stage.






