## Network Rules and Procedures amendments training

**This information has been prepared to inform Qualified Workers about the upcoming amendments to the Network Rules and Procedures.**

Keeping up to date with amendments to the Network Rules and Network Procedures is part of putting safety at our core to protect our employees, contractors and customers.

From Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021, the amendments to the Network Rules and Procedures become effective.

e-Learn training has been developed alongside the Network Rules and Procedures amendments to support Qualified Workers holding the following Safeworking Qualifications:

- Network Controller
- Protection Officer Levels 1-4
- Safeworking Officer Levels 1-2
- Signaller
- Station Staff (performing signalling operations)
- Track Vehicle Operator.

### How do I access the training?

The e-Learn training module can be accessed:

- by Sydney Trains, NSW Trains, and Transport for NSW employees through Transport Equip.
- by Contractors through the RIW platform.

### When will the e-Learn training need to be completed by?

Qualified Workers must complete the training module **before Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021**. The training will take only about 15-20 minutes.

If you require further assistance to navigate to the training module please contact your local Rail Safety Coach, Line Manager or RIW Administrator.

### Will all Qualified Workers be assigned the e-Learning training?

Only Network Controllers, Protection Officers 1-4, Safeworking Officers 1-2, Signallers, Station Staff (performing signalling operations) and Track Vehicle Operators will be assigned the e-Learn training.

### Which e-Learn training module should I complete?

e-Learn training modules should be completed as indicated below:

- Sydney Trains, NSW Trains, and Transport for NSW employees should complete e-Learn training modules as indicated below:
  - NPR2101E - Protection Officer Level 1
  - NPR2102E - Network Controller, Safeworking Officer Level 2, Signaller and Station Staff (performing signalling operations)
  - NPR2103E - Protection Officer Levels 2-4, Safeworking Officer Level 1 and Track Vehicle Operator
- Contractors
  - EL91 - Protection Officer Level 1
  - EL90 - Protection Officer Levels 2-4, Safeworking Officer Level 1 and Track Vehicle Operator

### What will I need to do if I am not directly affected by the amendments?
