MTMS STAGE 3A – SOUTH WESTERN WORKS CONVENTIONAL SIGNALLING UPGRADE – SEFTON PARK JUNCTION – STAGE 3

Commencing at 02:00 hours on **Saturday, 23 December 2023**, and continuing until 06:00 hours Sunday, 31 December 2023, the following works will be carried out:

- Existing 7CT Bungalow (at approx. Main South chainage 20.350km) will be renewed at the same location to new double width Signalling Location.
- The existing hi-rail access pad at approx. Main South chainage 20.370km on the UP & DOWN West forks will be removed and replaced with a new hi-rail access pad at approx. Main South chainage 20.393km to 20.424km.
- Installation of new Sefton Park 205 crossover (at approx. Main South chainage 20.313km to 20.378km Main South chainage) between the UP & DOWN West forks that will be commissioned into use in a later stage. Both ends will be clipped, XL locked and spiked in their normal position until commissioned.
- Installation of new 205 EOL and phone at approx. Main South chainage 20.495km. The EOL will be secured with a Falcon 4 lock.
- The new Sefton Park 205 crossover will be an unwired crossover & will be installed with post mounted Pantograph Down & Unwired Crossover Signage on approach to 205A and 205B points respectively. Details as follows:

Line	Direction	Approximate Kilometrage
Up West Fork	Down	Main South chainage 20.307km (For 205A points)
Down West Fork	Up	Main South chainage 20.386km (For 205B points)



- Note that signal SP31 at Main South chainage 20.560km is serving as reference points for the chainages mentioned above.
- A Driver's Diagram showing the new arrangement appears in this Weekly Notice. The drivers diagram uses chainages that matches the signalling plan and some assets have been given a Bankstown line chainage instead.



SYDNEY YARD (CENTRAL) – MTMS3 STAR PHASE 2 STAGE 1B - ENABLING WORKS TO RELOCATE EXISTING CABLES BETWEEN HOUSING DB1/9 & P10 - 12, RENEW P12 FRICTION BUFFER STOP AND P11 TEMPORARY WORKS

Commencing at 2300 hours on **Friday, 22 December 2023**, and continuing until 0200 hours on Sunday, 31st December 2023, the following works will be carried out:

- Frictional Buffer stop on Road 12 will be upgraded to cater for new NIF trains. Middle Road 9/10 buffer light previously booked out of use shall be removed.
- Signal Box and Yard master Telephones on the country end of Platforms 12/13 will be removed.
- The countryside section of Central Station Platform 11 will be removed and replaced with a temporary platform until further notice. There will be no changes to carmarker & fenceline positions. They will remain as per current position.
