CLYDE (INNER WEST) – AN96 AND AN98 SIGNAL UPGRADES AND 48 POINTS REMOVAL ENABLING WORKS

Commencing at 02:00 hours on **Friday, 26 December 2025**, and continuing until 22:00 hours on Sunday, 28 December 2025, the following work shall be carried out:

- Signal AN96 will be converted to LED. The form and indications will not change. Existing signal post telephone will be removed
- Signals AN98 will be converted to LED. Previously decommissioned low aspect will be removed. The remaining indications will not change. Existing signal post telephone will be removed
- Current booked out of use 48 points will be decommissioned and will have the infill panel removed with the A & B point ends retained spiked, clipped, locked and detected in the normal position.
- The Clyde indication panel will be amended to reflect the altered arrangements.
- The Clyde TVS ATRICS workstation will be updated to reflect the new layout at a later date

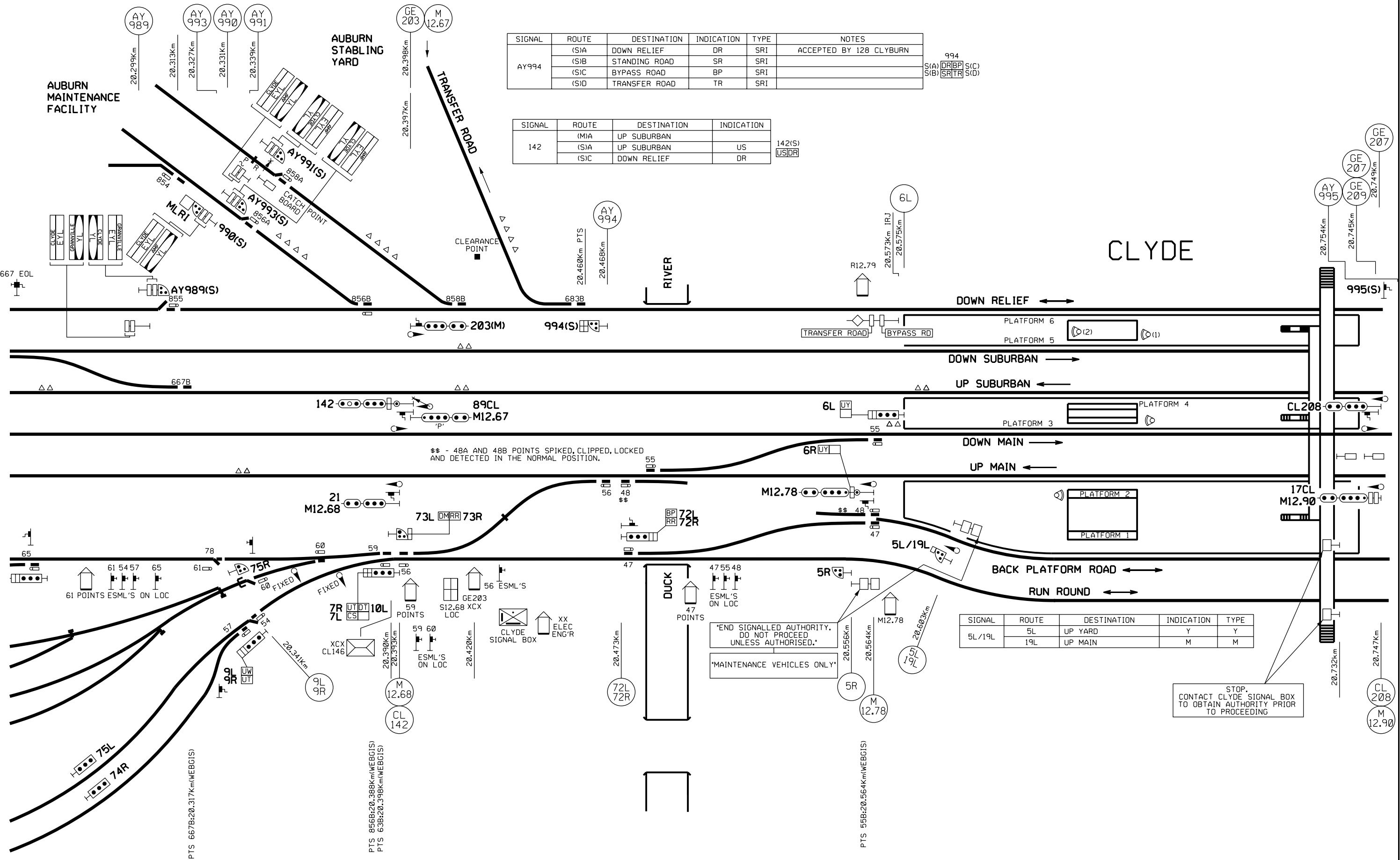

GOSFORD — COMMISSIONING OF AUTOMATIC TRAIN PROTECTION (ATP) ETCS LEVEL 1 LIMITED SUPERVISION

Commencing at 2030 hours on **Saturday, 20 December 2025** and continuing until 0500 hours on Sunday, 21 December 2025 Sydney Trains will commission into use Automatic Train Protection (ATP) ETCS Level 1 Limited Supervision in the Gosford area.

ATP will now be in service between Tascott and Narara.

- BEGIN ATP and END ATP signage and Level Transition balises will be removed from the Sydney-side of Point Clare.
- BEGIN ATP and END ATP signage and Level Transition balises will be removed from the country side of Narara.
- New ATP balises will be in-service in the Gosford area (between 77.230km and 85.560km) enforcing train speeds and for entering and exiting the car sidings and Down Sidings for ETCS fitted trains.
