

- New platform car marker & trackside stopping sign arrangements will be commissioned at the Valley Heights, Glenbrook and Blaxland stations to accommodate the new 4,6,8 and 10 car NIF trains
- The diagonal white tape shall be removed from car markers installed in an earlier stage. Details listed in table 1.
- Car marker changes as listed in table 02 below.
- Installation of a "POINTS CLEARED 10 CARS" post mounted sign on the DOWN MAIN (within VALLEY HEIGHTS, PLATFORM 2 limits).
   Sign is located on the left-hand side of the track reading in the Down Direction at approximately 77.331km.




- Construction of a temporary Mariyung Train Guards use only platform extension at the city end of platform 2 at Penrith. Refer to diagram 1 below for details.

- 243A/B & 244 Emergency Operation Lock of the keyless type (EOL) is provided on the down side of the Down Bankstown Line, near SY107 signal.



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# ASHFIELD (INNER WEST) – AUTOMATIC RECLEAR RESTORATION.

Commencing at 00:00 hours on **Saturday, 31 May 2025**, and continuing until 22:00 hours on Sunday, 1 June 2025, the following works will be carried out:

The signals listed below will be fitted with an automatic reclear ('auto reclear') function. All signals on each individual road must have their main routes set before the 'auto reclear' function can be engaged. The 'auto reclear' can be withdrawn by cancelling a signal route within the group or by its own control.

• Down Local Signals;

ST17L, ST23L, ST29L, ST35L, ST41L, ST47, ST51L, ST59L.

- Up Local Signals;
   ST82L, ST72L, ST62L, ST50L, ST42L.
- Down Suburban Signals;
   ST9S, ST15S, ST21S, ST27S, ST33S, ST39S.
- Up Suburban Signals;
   ST70S, ST60S, ST48S, ST40S, ST30S.
- Down Main Signals;
   ST1M, ST13M, ST19M, ST31M, ST37M.
- Up Main Signals

ST78M, ST58M, ST38M, ST28M.

Each road will have a separate auto reclear button named as such. With the route set, once a signal is placed in 'auto reclear', the "A" text next to the signal will change from black to green. If the signal route or 'auto reclear' is cancelled the "A" text will change from green to black.

Note; ST47 will be placed in 'auto reclear' via ST41L overset and will not have a "A" text display.
