

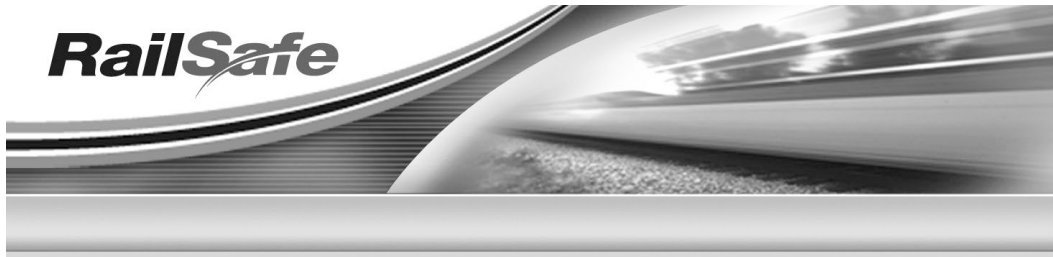

- A Driver's Diagram showing the new Redfern arrangement appears in this Weekly Notice.

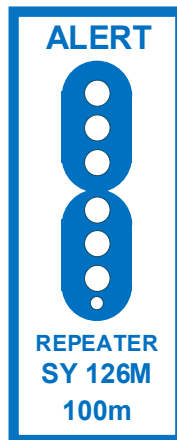


Diagram 1: New SY126 Repeater Signal Ahead Sign layout
