In conjunction with Special Train Notice No. 0244 – 2026 the following Safeworking arrangements will apply:

MORTDALE MAINTENANCE CENTRE – ROAD 1 AND 2

Approval is given for shunting movements of a train using a tractor or electric shunt vehicle within road 1 and 2 at Mortdale Maintenance Centre.

The following safeworking arrangements apply:

- Road 1 and 2 must be protected as a fixed worksite in accordance with the instructions shown in NWT 302 and NPR 700
- The PO and PPO must confer and come to a clear understanding for all shunting movements within road 1 and 2
- While the shunting movements are being undertaken, NO other fixed worksites, work trains or track vehicles will be permitted to traverse or occupy road 1 and 2. No persons other than those associated with the shunting movements are permitted within road 1 and 2 while shunting is being undertaken.
