In conjunction with Special Train Notice No. 1283 - 2026 the following Safeworking arrangements will apply:

EMERGENCY DETRAINMENT EXERCISE

In accordance with NWT 302 and NPR 700 and the possession arrangements detailed in Special Train Notice (STN) 1283 - 2026, an Emergency Detrainment Exercise will be carried out at Olympic Park.

Incident rail commander

The Incident Rail Commander must ensure that a Qualified Worker is provided to carry out the following:

- Ensure that appropriate protection is afforded to the possession area to prevent unauthorised entry
- Confer with the Possession Protection Officer (PPO) and come to a clear understanding on the protection to be afforded within the possession area for the exercise
- Confer with the Possession Protection Officer (PPO) and come to a clear understanding regarding the movements required of the special trains to be used for the exercise
- The Incident Rail Commander must also ensure that ALL participants always remain within the defined exercise area.
- On completion of the exercise, all participants must be accounted for, and the Possession Protection Officer (PPO) advised.

NOTE: No other worksites are permitted to be established in the possession area which are not part of the Emergency Detrainment exercise.

In accordance with the High-Visibility Vest and PPE Exemption Procedure, participants will not be required to wear Safety Vests and Personal Protective Equipment.

The Incident Rail Commander must ensure all requirements of the High-Visibility Safety Vest and PPE Exemption Procedure are met for the exercise.
