

Protection Officer's Log

Introduction

A Protection Officer's Log is used to record details associated with the use of a Track Work Authority (TWA).

The following fields on the Protection Officer's Log must be completed:

- Worksite location
- Type of work
- Start and finish kms
- Date
- Start and finish times.

Work Order No. is optional.

Handsignaller

Include details of the name and location of the Handsignaller(s).

Possession Protection Officer

Include details of the Possession Protection Officer if the TWA is associated with a Local Possession Authority (LPA).

Signaller

Include details of the Signaller responsible for the area in which the work is being done.

Rail traffic

Include details in the table of rail traffic that is authorised to pass the worksite.
