PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT OF WORK ON TRACK AT ABUTTING INTERFACE BOUNDARY LOCATIONS

From Monday, 8 July 2019 until Tuesday, 7 January 2020 this Permanent Safe Notice cancels and replaces Permanent Safe Notice 001 – 2019 due to expiry.

This Safe Notice has been issued in conjunction with the details listed in the Interface Agreement between Sydney Trains and Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC) and the applicable Network Local Appendices (NLA).

Where any work on track activity within the Sydney Trains network requires protection from the adjacent network owner, The Network Control Officers and the Protection Officer must establish a conference call to agree upon:

- affected rail traffic movements
- location of work
- required protection arrangements
- duration of work.

Worksite in Sydney Trains Network

Where the worksite is located within the Sydney Trains network, the Sydney Trains Network Control Officer must only authorise work to commence after the necessary assurances have been obtained from the ARTC Network Controller that the agreed protection has been applied.

All work on track methods within the Sydney Trains network must be implemented in accordance with the Sydney Trains Network Rules.

Worksite in ARTC Network

Where the worksite is located within the ARTC network, the ARTC Network Controller must only authorise work to commence after the necessary assurances have been obtained from the Sydney Trains Network Control Officer that the agreed protection has been applied.

All work on track methods within the ARTC network must be implemented in accordance with the ARTC Network Rules.
