## **Principle**

Shunting signals are:

- controlled signals, operated by Signallers or other Qualified Workers, and
- used to authorise shunting movements.

Shunting signals must be passed only in accordance with <u>NSG 606 Responding to signals and signs</u>.

The Figures in this Rule show examples of the shunting signals used in the Network.
